### **Ages 4-5-6**

#### **Crafts**

- 1) Make a crown of construction paper you could wear, sparkles, beads, stickers etc)
- 2) Print your first name on a piece of paper
- 3) Any colouring page – colour and/or decorate
- 4) Create a finger painting of a animal - named
- 5) Create an animal from playdough

#### **Baking**

- 6) Make a train from Rice Krispie squares
- 7) Bagel decorated like a clown
- 8) Make a large chocolate chip cookie for a birthday

#### **Horticulture**

- 9) A picture made of seeds and/or dried legumes glued on a piece of paper
- 10) Two stems of flowers and foliage in a water bottle
- 11) An animal creature made out of vegetables and/or fruit
- 12) A variety of 3 different kinds of mosses collected from the woods and displayed on a plate
- 13) A homemade fishing rod made out of a stick and string

### **Ages 7-8-9**

#### **Crafts**

- 14) Make a beaded suncatcher
- 15) Print "Fun at the Tweed Fair" on a piece of construction paper decorated
- 16) Create a stain glass window on 8 ½ x 11 sheet of paper
- 17) Make a animal puppet using a paper bag
- 18) Decorate a pair of sunglasses for a masacaraed party

#### **Baking**

- 19) Decorate 3 cupcakes like animals
- 20) 3 brownies decorated like Lego's
- 21) No bake family favorite cookie

#### **Horticulture**

- 22) A stone painted with a design. Maximum of 6 inches
- 23) A bouquet of mixed flowers in a container covered with birch bark

- 24) A Bristol board(or foam board) display of 4 different types of pine cones. Name the tree they are from and include a picture of what the tree looks like at maturity
- 25) Using natural products like birch bark, seeds, cones, etc. to make a picture in a shoe box lid
- 26) Use a pine cone as a base to make an animal

### **Ages 10-11-12**

#### **Crafts**

- 27) Make a Ferris Wheel out of construction paper, popsicle sticks
- 28) Print on lined paper:  
Popcorn, popcorn  
Sizzling in the pan.  
Shake it up, shake it up,  
Bam, bam, bam!  
  
Popcorn, Popcorn  
Now it's getting hot,  
Shake it up, shake it up  
Pop, pop, pop!

- 29) Nail art – (an article using hammer, nails and string to create art on wood-8"x8" max)
- 30) Decorate a mason jar (seasonal, candles, utensil holder etc – be creative)
- 31) Make a scrapbook page of your summer adventures (Max 12"x12")

#### **Baking**

- 32) Banana Muffins – 2 on a plate
- 33) Monster Cookie Bars – 2 on a plate
- 34) Decorate a small 8x8 square cake for a cake walk

#### **Horticulture**

- 35) An all natural centre piece made with evergreens. (Can include pine cones, seed heads, thistles, etc)
- 36) A picnic basket packed with treats for a kid's picnic
- 37) A piece of drift wood collected from the woods. Maximum size 20 inches
- 38) A collection of 6 photos taken in the woods and mounted on Bristol board or foam board
- 39) An Adirondack chair made out of wooden cloths pins
