Age 4-5-6

- 1. A bouquet of flowers made out of egg cartons and in a vase
- 2. An animal made out of a fruit or vegetable on a plate.
- 3. A painted stone. Maximum size 5 inches.
- 4. A seed art picture using a baby chicken picture as a base. Use a variety of seeds or dried legumes.
- 5. 2 stems of flowers in a vase with their foliage.

Age 7-8-9

- 1. An old CD made into art for the garden
- 2. A stone painted with a floral design. Maximum of 5 inches.
- 3. A collection of 5 different cones named with the tree they are from on a plate.
- 4. A floral arrangement made in a coffee mug.
- 5. A potato made into a porcupine using seeds etc. to decorate

Age 10-11-12

- 1. A bee hotel made out of natural garden material and wood.
- 2. A snake made out of a collection of painted stones on a piece of cardboard.
- 3. A centerpiece arrangement made using pine as the base greenery.
- 4. A vegetable train made with a minimum of 3 sections.
- 5. A wreath made using vine twisted as the base and natural greenery, cones and seeds to decorate it.

Adult

- 1. A collection of glass dishes recycled into a garden art piece
- 2. A rustic piece of wood transformed into a wall hanging for a door using fresh and natural materials.
- 3. Christmas in July centerpiece using a pedestal dish and pillar candle.
- 4. A bee hotel made out of wood and natural items. Maximum of 16 inches.
- 5. A collection of succulents planted. Minimum of 3 different varieties.
- 6. An old bicycle tire made into a door wreath. No purchased decorations.
- 7. Roses in a vase. Minimum of 3 flower heads.
- 8. 3 Hosta flower stems in a vase with their greenery.
- 9. Miniature arrangement not to exceed 4 inches in any direction.
- 10. A collection of garden flowers in a vase.
