  - Any cattle arriving after 8:30am on the day of the show will be subject to disqualification, unless communicated with organizers.
  - Exhibitors will be released following the completion of the Open Breed Classes, arrangements can be made with the organizers for people who are traveling long distances.

#### **YOUTH SHOW**

CLASS 1: SHOWMANSHIP — divisions for youth aged peewee to 21 years old

- A Peewee Showmanship youth aged 0-8 years old
- B Novice Showmanship youth aged 9-11 years old
- C Junior Showmanship youth aged 12-14 years old
- D Intermediate Showmanship youth aged 15-17 years old
- E Senior Showmanship = youth aged 18-21 years old

## **OPEN BREED CLASSES**

CLASS 3: BULL CALF – bull calves born on or after January 1st current year

CLASS 4: BREEDING AGE BULL - bulls born in calendar years 2024 and 2023

CLASS 5: HEIFER CALF - heifer calves born on or after January 1st current year

CLASS 6: YEARLING HEIFER – yearlings born in calendar year 2024, heats divided by age

CLASS 6: COW/CALF PAIRS – any aged cow with her own natural calf at foot, calf must be born after Jan 1st 2025

CLASS 7: BREEDERS HERD – four animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented

CLASS 8: GET OF SIRE – three animals that have the same sire, both sexes represented

CLASS 9: PROGENY OF DAM - two animals that are product of the same dam

Selection of 2025 Masterfeeds Royal Agricultural Winter Fair Beef Supreme Qualifiers to be completed following their respective classes and divisions

#### **SHOW RULES**

- Entry fee is \$20 per animal
- A cow/calf pair is one 'animal', if you are going to split the calf that is an additional 'animal'
- Entry fees are to be paid through the Showman entry system
- ENTRY DUE DATE IS JUNE 25TH 2025
- Cow/calf pairs may be split
- Classes will be split by breed, in order for a breed class to be utilized there must be at least one class with six entries. (i.e. heifer calves have six entries and yearlings have one entry, breed class will be supported)
- There will be no substitutions or additions after the deadline

#### **ENTRY FORMS**

#### OTHER NOTES

- No bedding will be provided, straw or shavings are recommended.
- There is no hydro access, generators are highly recommended
- Washing facilities are not ideal, if you have the ability to wash at home before the show that is recommended
- Some cattle may be tied outdoors, pop-up tents would be a good idea
- There is limited overnight space for cattle, if you would like to bring cattle on the Friday prior to the
  event or leave them overnight after the event please reach out to Eric to arrange. Any cattle left
  overnight will not be monitored and are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- Camping may take place on the fairgrounds. No campfires, no water or hydro access available. Please make arrangements with the organizer for this option.
- We are expecting in excess of 150 head of cattle and over 50 youth to attend this event. We will do
  our best to adhere to a quick pace through the ring. It is key that you be on time for your class.
